

Catholic Men For Christ Committee

The Catholic Men For Christ Committee exists as a consultative body to the Archdiocese of St. Louis for the planning and promotion of the annual Catholic Men For Christ conference. The committee is under the direction of the Office of Evangelization and Discipleship. The conference exists for building up Catholic Men in the Archdiocese of St. Louis by engaging, educating, and encouraging all Catholic men to live their faith and to lead their families in accordance with the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Members are eligible for a 3 year term on the committee that may be renewed only 1 time. All committee members must be a Catholic in good standing, of sound moral character and have the recommendation of His parish Pastor.

Role Descriptions



Chairman

The CMFC Conference Committee Chairman is the primary representative from the CMFC committee to the Archdiocese of St. Louis. The chairman is responsible for assisting the Archdiocese in selecting committee members, convening meetings and ensuring that the conferences achieve the intended mission of building up Catholic Men in the Archdiocese of St. Louis by engaging, educating, and encouraging all Catholic men to live their faith and to lead their families in accordance with the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Deanery Captain (6)

The primary contact for a the parish captains of a particular deanery. Attend committee meetings to consult on speakers, themes, conference format etc...

1. Contact Parish Captains in your deanery to find out if they are *still* active:
**If they are not active, either reach out to the Pastor and ask for a suggestion, or see who/if anyone attended from this parish last year and reach out to them.*
2. Recruit Parish Captains for parishes without one by asking to the Pastor/parish ministry lead
3. Attend Kickoff and invite Parish Captains to Kickoff in September
4. Ensure Parish Captains receive conference info / promo material
5. Following up with Parish Captains through regular check ins and support
6. Help promote the conference to parishes with parish captains and talk with those Pastors to ask them to help advertise within their parish
7. Attend CMFC Committee Meetings and give feedback on conference speakers, themes and schedule.
8. Encourage parish captains to support parish based men's ministry after the conference.

Young Adult Representative

A member of the young adult community who can give input on speaker recommendations, theme development and serve as the primary liaison for recruiting young adults (ages 22-35) to attend the conference.

Sponsorships & Vendors Coordinator

Assist the conference planners in soliciting conference sponsors and advertisers from the Catholic business community. Attend committee meetings to consult on speakers, themes, conference format etc...

Liturgy & Confession Coordinator

Assist the conference planners in planning the liturgical aspects of the conference including mass, confession, prayer ministry, adoration chapel and more. Attend committee meetings to consult on speakers, themes, conference format etc...

Volunteer Coordinator

Assist the conference planners in securing and directing volunteers for the conference, including set up, clean up and conference hospitality. Attend committee meetings to consult on speakers, themes, conference format etc...

Parish Captain

The primary contact of a parish for CMFC responsible for promotion of the conference at the local level, especially by making personal invitations to men in the parish. Parish captains do not attend the CMFC Committee meetings.

1. Attend CMFC Kickoff: September
2. Pick up conference promotional materials at Cardinal Rigali Center or Vicariate Office
3. Hang posters and flyers in church vestibule (with Pastor permission)
4. Submit Advertisement to Parish Secretary/Bulletin Editor by October 1 for recurring ads in the bulletin and online
5. Ask Pastor to give announcement and offer to give a pulpit talk
6. Speak at Knights of Columbus meeting, Men's Group meeting, etc.
7. Contact parish youth minister - student price starts at \$15 (8th grade through college)
8. Contact men from your parish who attended last year.
9. Support parish-based men's ministry after the conference.
